

How to Calculate Your GPA

Each letter grade is assigned a certain amount of points, as demonstrated by the chart below.

<u>Letter Grade</u>	<u>Points</u>
A	4
B	3
C	2
D	1
F,I	0

Step 1

Take the total amount of points you earned for the credits that were attempted for the term you are calculating. For example:

<u>Course</u>	<u>Credit Hrs. Att</u>	<u>Grade</u>	<u>Total Points</u>
Mat 101	3	C	3(2)=6
Spa 101	3	B	3(3)=9
PHE 111	1	A	1(4)=4
MUS 101	3	A	3(4)=12
MI 101	2	C	2(2)=4
Total Credits	12	Total Points	35

Step 2

Divide the total amount of points by the total amount of credits hours attempted (ex. $35/12=2.91$). This student would have completed the semester with a 2.91 GPA.

CUMULATIVE GPA

Your Cumulative GPA can be calculated using a similar method. Take the total amount of cumulative points earned and divide that number by the total amount of credits attempted to calculate your cumulative GPA. This will give you your cumulative GPA.

<u>Cumulative Credit Hrs Att</u>	<u>Cumulative Points</u>	<u>GPA</u>
60	195	3.25
