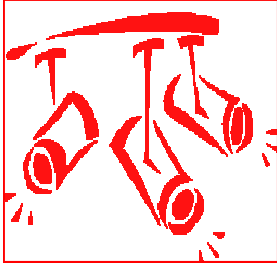




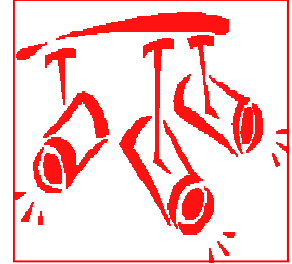

Eligibility Rules: You must not be married nor have any children. You must be between the ages of 13 and 17. You must be 13 before June 2007 and if you are 17 you must NOT be a high school senior. You must reside in either Madison County or Hinds County or attend school in either Madison County or Hinds County.

Phases of Competition: The scored competition areas are interview, casual wear, active wear, talent, and evening wear. You will need a suit or dress for the interview, jeans and a nice shirt with your choice of shoes for casual wear, an aerobic wear or jogging outfit and tennis shoes for active wear, talent outfit suited to your talent and a long formal evening gown. Our theme is a *"A Showcase of Magnolia Beauty, Brains & Talent"*!

Entry Fee: A \$100.00 entry fee must be submitted with the application package.

Sponsors: The contestants' sponsor fee is \$100 per sponsor. Only one sponsor may be listed on each form – each sponsor will have a page in the program booklet. Each contestant must secure at least three sponsors. However, you may obtain as many sponsors as you like.

Other Information: Your interview will be a total of 12 minutes with a 60 second introduction at the beginning and a final remark at the end of the interview. Your talent must not exceed two minutes. For each minute that your talent exceeds 2 minutes, points will be deducted. We will have a rehearsal on the Friday night before the pageant in the Holmes Hall auditorium on the campus of Tougaloo College. All participants are required to attend. All checks are to be payable to the Tougaloo College OTP.
