STUDENT TRAINEE - STUDENT CAREER EXPERIENCE PROGRAM (SCEP)

SALARY RANGE: starting salary between \$11.74 - \$14.74 USD per hour

APPLICATION SUBMISSION PERIOD: November 30 - December 14, 2009

START DATE: Spring 2010 semester (on or about mid-January 2010)

SERIES & GRADE: YP-1199-01 or YP-0399-01

POSITION INFORMATION: The SCEP program provides for periods of attendance at accredited schools combined with periods of career-related work. Students who have met all the requirements of this program may be noncompetitively converted to a career or career-conditional appointment in an occupation related to their academic training and work-study experiences.

DUTY LOCATION: Department of the Army, Headquarters, U.S. Joint Munitions Command (JMC), Commodity Management Directorate, Rock Island Arsenal, Rock Island, IL 61299-6000. There are eight divisions within the Commodity Management Directorate; seven divisions are ammunition commodity focused and one is primarily focused on policy, training and maintenance.

WHO MAY BE CONSIDERED: Applications will be accepted from degree seeking students enrolled in their junior or senior year. Degree must be related to the positions being filled. We are specifically looking for Business Administration and Industrial Technology degrees at this time.

REQUIREMENTS:

- * Open to U.S. Citizens
- * Must be enrolled at least ½ time
- * May be converted to career or career-conditional appointment within 120 days after satisfactory completion of degree requirements
- * Meet security requirements

JOB SUMMARY:

The student will provide support to the Commodity Management Directorate on various projects and assignments within the directorate with oversight from a Team Lead or Senior Action Officer. The student will perform tasks related to production management or equipment specialist. These assignments can include production planning, review and analysis of data, data cleansing, entering production data within a SAP based system, monitoring production schedules, preparing and presenting briefings. The student may also be required to travel (accompanied) to production facilities and other Government/Commercial offices.
