The DCPS Urban Education Leaders Internship Program (UELIP) is an intensive multi-disciplinary internship program that runs during the academic school year, administered by the Office of the Chancellor. Interns will work alongside the Chancellor's senior staff and have a chance to be mentored by cabinet level members on leadership development, coaching and training. Interns receive extensive professional development including power lunches with leaders in the school system, school site visits, coffee talks with education leaders outside the organization, and career development panels.
