

Broadcast Technician, Lead

Department -Technical Services (Master Control)

JOB DUTIES INCLUDE:

This is a leadership level position in the Technical Services Division involving the operation of television electronic equipment. Primary responsibilities of this position require airing regular broadcast schedules and network recordings, managing special circumstances and solving problems as necessary. This position requires operating a wide range of complex broadcasting equipment such as the Harris Icon Master switcher, Sony DVW-A500, Omneon Server, BVW-75, Leitch routing switcher, AXESS Master Control Transmitter sites remote computer, Tape Duplication systems, and Satellite receivers. Employee ensures that all operations are within FCC and MPB network regulations at the designated working sites. Supervision is received from a department supervisor, but the employee is required to make some technical decisions without supervision. Lifting/weight requirement 60 pounds.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

An Associate's Degree from an accredited two-year college in Electronics or a directly related field, (AND) two (2) years of experience in work directly related to the above described duties; (OR) Graduation from a standard four-year high school or equivalent (GED), (AND) four (4) years of experience in work directly related to the above described duties; (OR) Above graduation from a standard four-year high school or equivalent (GED), directly related education and directly related experience may be substituted on an equal basis. Must be able to work varying shifts all hours of the day and night. May be called to work for extended periods during emergencies or special needs.
