

## Broadcast Technician Senior

### JOB DUTIES INCLUDE:

Mississippi Public Broadcasting is seeking an Operator for the 3:00pm to 11:00pm shift in the Master Control Studio. This Studio is responsible for all technical aspects of television and radio broadcasting. This position requires the use of digital high definition broadcasting equipment in accordance with MPB standards and FCC rules and regulations. Incumbent must have operational and proficiency skills in all Master Control equipment, including but not limited to automation equipment, videotape machines, satellite receivers and remote transmitter operation. Supervision is received from a department supervisor, but the employee is required to make some technical decisions without supervision. Lifting/weight requirement 85 pounds.

### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

An Associate's Degree from an accredited two-year college in Electronics or a directly related field (AND) one (1) year of experience in work directly related to the above-described duties; (OR) Graduation from a standard four-year high school or equivalent (GED), (AND) three (3) years of experience in work directly related to the above-described duties; (OR) Above graduation from a standard four-year high school or equivalent (GED), directly related education and directly related experience may be substituted on an equal basis. Must be able to work varying shifts all hours of the day and night. May be called to work for extended periods during emergencies or special needs.
