Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards ensure that you are successfully completing your coursework and can continue to receive financial aid. All students receiving financial aid are required to meet SAP standards. Students who do not meet the colleges and Department of Education's SAP requirements may be denied financial aid. Student may appeal the denial based on extenuating circumstances.

- Submit supporting documentation of <u>extenuating circumstances</u> (if applicable).
- Complete SAP Academic Plan with academic advisor.
