IMPORTANT STUDENT REMINDERS

All Applicants: Fill out application neatly and completely. Respond to all questions. If a question does not apply to you, use "N/A" to indicate that it is not applicable.

Please add cazogini@tougaloo.edu to your safe senders' email list. All correspondences will be done via this email address and it is important that you receive all communications.

All students (this includes: *recently graduated from high school and is classified as incoming freshman; currently enrolled student; and/or transfer student*), you *must* adhere to the following requirements in order to be eligible to receive a scholarship through private donor funds administered by the Division of Institutional Advancement.

- Completed the enrollment process;
- Submitted all necessary documents to the Financial Aid Office;
- Created a profile with UNCF; and
- Applied for the UNCF General Scholarship (deadline March 31st)

The Development Scholarships Student Application will require several uploaded documents. The following file types will NOT be accepted: msg., tex., zip., odt, html, pages, exe., jar, and cmd.

File types that will be accepted include: pdf, word, png and jpeg.

There are a number of scholarships that require an essay—please make sure that you submit the essay. You can compose your essay and upload it onto the online application. Read all instruction carefully.

Instructions

- Complete and submit the online Development Scholarships Student Application Form by *March 31st* for the upcoming academic year and *October 15th* for Transfer Students.
- Carefully read the scholarship's description and eligibility criteria. Your written essay and responses will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. Please be intentional, direct, and thoughtful in your response to all questions, regarding you, your experiences, and the qualities you possess that make you a candidate for the scholarship(s) for which you are applying.
- In addition to your academic information, you may be asked to provide written responses related to any intended career path, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, community service and leadership experience.
- Students classified as graduating Seniors are still eligible to apply.
