## Senior Counselor-Upward Bound Program

**Position Summary**: Assumes the responsibility for individual and group counseling activities and for the maintenance of program files, maintaining accurate and confidential records of all participants' contacts and records progress toward matriculation. Assists the Assistant Director in interviewing and selecting students for participation in the program and the development of cultural activities and college tours; assists in the evaluation of academic, personal and career needs of the participants in the program; completes Individual Educational Plans for assigned students; participates in in-service training; staff development workshops/activities and departmental meetings; provides professional guidance and counseling (social, academic, career and financial aid). Prepare monthly reports detailing accomplishments, problems encountered, projections, etc. Attends state or regional conferences and performs other duties assigned by the Assistant Director. Senior Counselor (s) will be assigned to target schools. Travel is required. Work approximately tow (2) Saturday per month (September-April) and summer residential camp for six weeks (June-July) of each year.

**Duties:** Under the supervision of the Assistant Director, the Senior Counselor will be responsible for providing professional guidance and counseling, demonstrating the ability to organize records, conduct conferences, make referrals, plan and organize extra-curricular activities, ability to promote the total growth of the student's ability to develop, disseminate and collect, acquire and maintain information systems designed to assess participant's progress, demonstrate the ability to interact positively with students from various backgrounds.

**Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:** A minimum of a Master's Degree in Guidance and Counseling, Social Work, or a related field. A minimum of three (3) years in a position performing the above duties and responsibilities; experience in working with low income, first generation and disadvantaged students.
