The successful candidate will also be able to accompany vocal students and faculty on recitals as well as provide accompaniment for the Concert Choir when requested. This faculty member will be expected to maintain a professional regional and national profile and actively pursue a piano performance agenda. The successful candidate will participate in departmental recitals, student recruitment, and advising music majors within the Department of Visual and Performing Arts.
