TOUGALOO COLLEGE Seeks: Assistant/ Associate Professor of Computer Science (Cybersecurity)

Position Summary:

Tougaloo is accepting applications for a full-time tenure-track position in Computer Science/Engineering with primary responsibilities for developing and expanding the College's Cybersecurity Program. In pursuit of an externally funded research program, the candidate for this position will collaborate with the Tougaloo College Research and Development Foundation, a co-sponsor for this appointment. Teaching load will be reduced to facilitate research collaboration with the foundation. The candidate is expected to participate in professional/service activities and to integrate into the life of Tougaloo College.

Tougaloo College is a private, Historically Black College (HBCU), located in a suburban area of Jackson, Mississippi. Tougaloo College offers degrees in both bachelor and master level studies. As a small, private HBCU, the college serves students of various social and economic backgrounds and experiences. Founded in 1869, the College has distinguished itself as a critical educational resource for the State of Mississippi and the nation.

Experience/Qualifications:

Required (minimum) qualifications:

- Ph.D. in Computer Science, Computer Engineering, Cybersecurity or a related field upon start date.
- Potential to build a nationally recognized, externally funded research program.
- Evidence of scholarly and professional achievements commensurate with experience.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Research and teaching expertise that enhances the capabilities and strengths of the Math and Computer Science Department, especially in the area of cybersecurity. We also encourage applications from candidates whose research and teaching expertise complement existing faculty expertise and/or data science related.
- Ability to work with and engage diverse students and colleagues within and outside the Computer Science program. Ability to promote the advancement of diversity and inclusion in computer science.
