TOUGALOO COLLEGE Seeks: Student Success Coach for SOARS Program

Position Summary:

Historic Tougaloo College, a private, coeducational, four-year liberal arts institution, invites highly motivated, bold, and innovative candidates to submit applications for the position of Student Success Coach for the SOARS (Successful Orientation, Advising, and Retention of Students) Program.

SOARS is a student-centered program designed to help students navigate the academic and social life of the College. The Student Success Coach is part of a leadership team that assumes shared responsibility for the retention of Tougaloo students. The successful candidate will be committed to the Tougaloo tradition of critical inquiry and social justice. Change agents and visionaries are encouraged to apply. This is a full-time, 12-month position that may require some evenings, weekends, and travel.

Drawing on guidance strategies grounded in quantitative and qualitative methodology, the Student Success Coach will meet weekly with new and first year students, lead student success seminars, advise students regarding majors, proficiency exams, FAFSA, community service and all requirements for graduation. The Success Coach will enjoy opportunities to produce forums on subjects ranging from the practical to the theoretical, the historic to the trending, and the scientific to the artistic. The successful candidate will monitor and mentor "at risk" students; introduce students to resources provided by the College, including tutoring, career counseling, travel opportunities, internships, health services, and financial planning; cultivate collegial working relationships with faculty; leverage technology as an outreach vehicle; participate in Tougaloo activities; and fulfill other duties as assigned.
