

TOUGALOO GOLLEGE 2017-2018 Custom Verification Worksheet **Federal Aid Programs**

Your financial aid application has been chosen for a review process called "Verification." Custom Verification is a process by which Tougaloo College compares the information on your application with the documentation stating your high school completion status, identity and statement of educational purpose. The law says that our institution has a right to ask for this information before we award you Federal aid. If there are differences in the application and the financial documents, then an electronic correction is made to your application.

What you should do for verification?

- Complete and **sign** this verification worksheet. 1.
- Return with this worksheet, documentation that proves your high school completion status.
- Come by the office to complete the identity and educational statement of purpose (must be signed in office)
- 4. Submit the information to the financial aid office as soon as possible.
- Once the financial aid office has your documentation, the verification will be completed and any corrections will be made by the financial aid office.
- Once verification is completed, then you can be awarded federal aid.
